Once you can do that, you should be able to open the.rar file with any standard unzip program.Count Down Music Festival 2004 The Count Down Music Festival 2004 was a music festival which took place at the Middlesbrough Football Centre, Middlesbrough, England on the weekend of 16-18 May 2004. The festival was organised by Festival Republic. The three-day event featured headline performances from established artists, as well as showcases from new, indie and alternative bands. The event was promoted as being the successor to the previous year's Pop-a-Pies, and while several acts involved with the festival would go on to form the short-lived group the Baseballs, the majority of acts were featured due to existing connections. The success of the 2003 event saw the festival expanded for the 2004 event. Although it was still technically the main headliner, Count Down combined The Verve's performance from the previous year with a new opening act, and added a second stage: the 'Garage'. There were several other additions to the event, which included an accommodation and after-party ticket package. Another ticket, entitled the 'Door Prize' was given away to the first two hundred people to enter the event. Tickets for the event sold out within three days, and the 'Garage' stage attracted 35,000 attendees. The 2004 event was advertised as being the 'first pop-up pop-up gig' and over the three days events were held at the cricket ground, Middlesbrough College, the tram station and the Middlesbrough Institute of Modern Art (MIMA) on the Saturday, and at the South Bank and New Ocean club on the Sunday.
